Dear Supporters of Cornell Women's Ice Hockey,

The summer is once again flying by and there have been many exciting events occurring with Cornell Women's Ice Hockey even though we are not yet in season!

We had two of our players centralized by the Canadian Olympic Team. That means they will be taking a year off from Cornell to play with the National team and hopefully make the Olympic Team. Sophomore Rebecca Johnston, who was a Patty Kazmeier top 10 finalist as the most valuable player in the NCAA, and Brienne Jenner who had been admitted to Cornell for 2009, will both be vying for a spot on the Canadian Olympic Team. Twenty six players were selected and twenty one will be chosen in January to play in the 2010 Olympic Winter Games in Vancouver, Canada. It is an unbelievable honor to be chosen by your country, and we wish them all the best this season!



We also had four players selected to participate in tryouts for the Canadian Under 22 team. Sophomores Chelsea Karpenko and Catherine White were selected along with incoming freshmen defensemen, Laura Fortino and Lauriane Rougeau. The players that are chosen for the team will then play a series versus the centralized Olympic team. Congratulations to all four players!

As I mentioned earlier we were supposed to have three new players joining us this fall but since Brienne Jenner was selected by the Canadian Olympic program we will have to wait until 2010 to see her in the Cornell red and white. We will have two new defensemen joining us, Laura Fortino and Lauriane Rougeau. Lauriane served as captain of the U18 Canadian National Team in 2007-08 and was a member of the U22 National Team in 2008-09. She also played with the Dawson College Blues and Team Quebec last season. She is from Beaconsfield, Quebec. Laura Fortino played for the Canadian U18 National Team in 2008-09 while also playing with Team Ontario and the Stoney Creek Jr. Sabres. Laura is from Hamilton, Ontario. We are very excited to have both of them joining us. You are going to love watching these two individuals play the next four years at Cornell.

On the coaching front, Assistant Coach Kim Insalaco got married this summer and has left us to join her husband, Chris Legg in Washington, DC. Her wedding was held at Sage Hall and was a beautiful occasion. We thank her for her hard work and dedication to our program and we will certainly miss her. We wish Chris and Kim lots of happiness together!

We hired a new assistant coach on August 1st, Edith Zimmering. Edith is a 2005 graduate of Elmira College who has spent the last two seasons as an assistant coach at Brown University. Edith won two national championships as a goaltender for Elmira College so she knows what it takes to win. She has also helped Nicole Stock at Brown University to become one of the top goalies in our league. We are very excited to have an experienced goaltender, coach, and Ivy League recruiter, join our staff at Cornell.

We are very excited about our upcoming season. We have shown steady improvement the last three seasons and now we are planning to take the next step. We still have a young team but we have gained valuable playoff experience the last two seasons. We have a strong willed group that is ready to show the rest of the league that we are a team to be reckoned with regardless of the fact that we lost two players to the Canadian Olympic team. This is a group with a tremendous amount of Big Red pride and they cannot wait to get started. We look forward to seeing you at Lynah this fall.
