Dear Cornell Hockey Supporters,

I am so honored and pleased to finally announce that former Cornell Women's Ice Hockey Coach, William Duthie '71 will be inducted into the Cornell Athletics Hall of Fame on Friday Oct. 9th, 2009 at the Statler Hotel.



Bill coached the Women's Ice Hockey team from 1972-1984. His teams won 135 games! During that time span they won 6 straight Ivy League titles!! What an incredible accomplishment! Bill had 13 All-Ivy first team selections. His teams compiled three consecutive 17-win seasons from 1976-80. His best season was the 1979-80 campaign when the Big Red won its fifth straight league crown, finished second at both the Granite State Tournament and the Concordia Invitational, and recorded a third-place performance at the first-ever AIAW championship. As a wing for the men's ice hockey team, Bill was a member of Cornell's historic undefeated (29-0) season (1969-70) en route to the national championship. He served as tri-captain for the 1970-71 season. Bill was also the recipient of the Sam Woodside award for most improved player in 1971.

As incredible as those feats are, what is even more amazing is the love that his former players still have for him today. We had our 35th reunion two summers ago and our alumnae from that era could not stop talking about the good times they shared with Coach Bill Duthie. The championships they won are an incredible feat, but the life long lessons and memories that he helped bestow upon his players will be passed on through the generations. Every coach is hopeful that they will teach their players life long lessons and leave them with fond memories they will cherish the rest of their lives. Coach Bill Duthie did exactly that.

For those of you who can make it to Cornell for the weekend we will be holding a small surprise get together after the Cornell/Harvard football game on Saturday Oct.10th. We will have it in Lynah Rink in the Ned Harkness room. Come over after the football game and enjoy some snacks and refreshments and share in Bill's celebration. For those of you who want to attend but are not going to the football game, I expect it to begin around 3 pm.
