Coach's Corner

It's great to begin another hockey season at Cornell. It hardly seems possible that this is my 19th year back on campus. We have high expectations for this year's team, and other people do too. Having not played a game yet, we are ranked No. 5 in the country.

We are working hard on the ice to justify that high ranking and to manage these expectations. The Red-White scrimmage created a lot of excitement, but it was just that....a scrimmage that was a lot of fun for all of us.

This team has much more experience than we had a year ago when we went 19-9-7 and lost to Ferris State in the Midwest Region finals. Sixteen letter winners have returned, and seven of the top eight scorers are back on the ice for us. Nine NHL draftees will be skating for the Big Red this season.

As a team, we allowed just 2.17 goals per game in 2011-12. This just doesn't happen by chance. Five of our defensemen have been drafted by the NHL, and the last line of defense, junior Andy Iles, is one of the best goal-tenders in the country.

When you look at our schedule, obviously there are challenges. Big Red fans will have the opportunity to see possibly the best non-conference schedule in the history of the program. Seven of our opponents are currently ranked in the top 20 in the country.

And then there is the best single game event in college hockey when we go to Madison Square Garden to face Michigan the Saturday after Thanksgiving (Nov. 24). We last faced the Wolverines in the 2012 NCAA Midwest Region semifinal contest that we won 3-2 in overtime.

Once again, the ECAC will be highly competitive, and we expect to be right there in the running for the championship.

I want to take this opportunity to thank the CHA for helping us buy a new video system that will be a tremendous teaching tool for us coaches and benefit the players tremendously.

I would also like to invite you to join our Cornell Hockey Coach's Club. We meet on most Fridays on home game weekends. At our annual convention, coaches have often told me how they envy the kind of support given to our program. This only happens through the generosity of our loyal fans of the CHA. You can find more information about the Coach's Club on the CHA website.

We look forward to seeing you amongst the Lynah Faithful, and in many of the visiting rinks.

I hope everyone had a great summer. We really enjoyed the CHA picnic once again. I always feel that is the signal to the start of a new hockey season! I hope to see many of you at our games this year at Lynah! The ECAC Women's Hockey is going to be very competitive this year. The strength of our league from top to bottom is the best I have seen over the last six years.



It should be a really exciting year for the Cornell Women's Team as we have eight freshmen this year. This is our biggest class of freshmen that we have ever recruited. We have added skill and depth at every position.

In goal we have our junior, Lauren Slebodnick who has a career lowest goals against average at 1.31 and the highest save percentage at .933 of any goaltender in Cornell history! Sophomore Katelyn Pippy also gained valuable experience last year and will challenge for the starting role. She is also poised to take the mantle as our new anthem singer after the departure of Amanda Young! We also have a freshmen goaltender, Stefannie Moak from Nova Scotia who is a strong technical goaltender that will push both of our veterans for playing time.

At the forward position we have also added some depth with our freshmen as we lost four forwards to graduation. We only have one senior this year, Erin Barley-Maloney who had an impressive second half of the season last year. Our juniors are Jess Campbell, Olivia Cook, and Brianne Jenner all of whom have played extensive roles already and will be looked upon to step up this season. In the sophomore class, we have Emily Fulton, Monika Leck, and Jillian Saulnier. They each made big contributions as freshmen and will be relied upon again this year to take their games to the next level. Our freshmen are Jess Brown, Victoria Pittens, Taylor Woods and Anna Zorn. This is a young group of forwards but they are all skilled competitors.

So that is the Cornell Women's Hockey team for this year. It is a young group, but also a highly skilled and competitive group of players. It is always exciting to have a youthful group full of energy and enthusiasm. That is what you will see from this team as they will outwork their opponents. It will be fun for the fans to watch!
